Off-Road vehicles/ATV's and Motocross bikes

Dear Resident:

The Township of Woolwich, the Waterloo Regional Police Service and property owners are co-coordinating enforcement efforts again this year, in the Breslau area, to curb off-road vehicle activities.

We believe that together we can have a considerable impact on reducing unlawful behaviours, such as trespassing and noise.

When reporting incidents of off-road vehicle noise or trespassing residents are encouraged to call **both** the Waterloo Regional Police Service AND the Township of Woolwich By-law Enforcement line.

The Waterloo Regional Police Communications Center is 519-653-7700; include as much detail as possible. Regional Police respond to calls for service based on a priority level including the potential impact on community safety. Please be advised that the Regional Police response times may vary based on the time of day, and ongoing demand on police resources; however residents are encouraged to report any activity that may violate a Federal, Provincial or Municipal Law.

The Township of Woolwich Municipal Law Enforcement call line is 519-664-2613 Ext 6009(local call) or 519-669-1647 Ext 6009. We also need as much information as possible, including anything that will assist us in further identifying violators. All complaint information is confidential.
